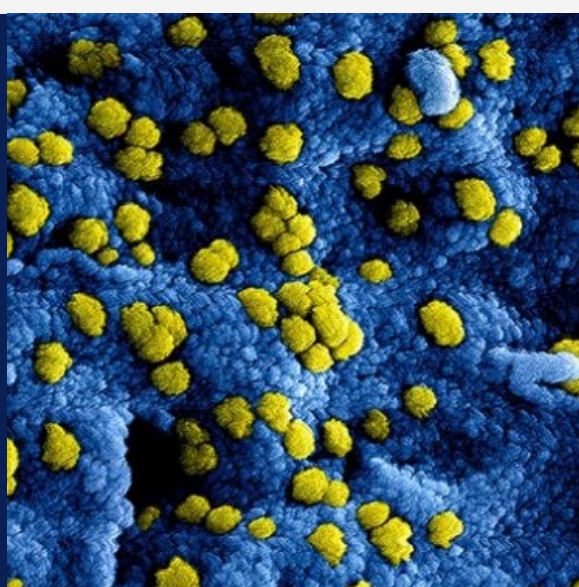

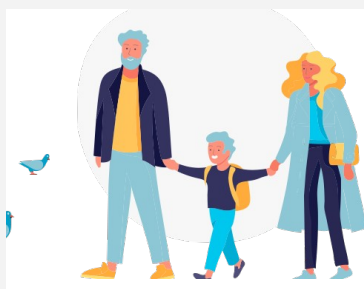


We are looking for you!

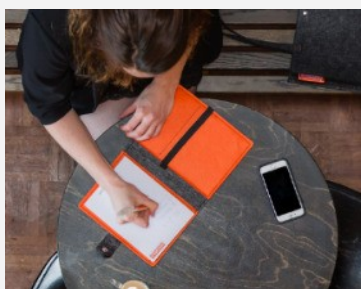
